John Jacobs Invitational University of Oklahoma Norman 4/9/93

NORMAN -- An almost perfect day saw the Norman girls and Eisenhower boys walk away with the Division I team titles in the John Jacobs Invitational held here April 9th. Weather conditions were excellent with mild temperatures, sunshine and not much wind. The Jacobs Track is an excellent facility and the crowd was treated to a host of season-leading performances. Norman out-scored runnerup Eisenhower 110-78 with no relay wins and only two individual titles from shot putter Kristy Dale and 200m sprinter Monica Leon. The Eisenhower boys had about the same margin in defeating the Edmond Bulldogs, 109-70, taking the 4x100 and 4x400 relay titles and getting both individual hurdle golds with Raymond Austin including a new meet record of 14.22 in the 110 meters. Ike's long jumper, Josh Brown, added another first place with a leap of 22-8.5.

In Division II the John Marshall girls put on an awesome display of their strength, taking all the relay titles and adding six individual titles as well. Talea Wisby captured three of the six title, taking the 100m hurdles, 300m hurdles and the long jump. The boys side was much more balanced with Okmulgee taking the 4x100 and 4x400 relay titles while Douglass' Dedrick Marsh doubled in the 100m and 200m dashes. Phillip Price of Catoosa lowered his own season leading 1600m mark to an outstanding 4:14.08.

The first issue of Oklahoma TRACK & FIELD NEWS was a big hit with coaches, parents, fans and athletes and I'm delighted with the overwhelming positive response from everyone that has taken the time to let me know that they appreciate the effort. I've enjoyed getting to know the people involved in track at several meets over the past few weeks and I'm looking forward to meeting as many as possible in the future.

This issue covers about twice as many meets as were reported in the first issue but we are still not getting all the results of meets in the state or involving state teams competing out of state. Please let the meet director of any competition that you attend know that he needs to send the results to us as soon as possible. All results, if they are readable, will be used, regardless of school or size. The "readable" requirement is important, especially when we are trying to get results typed on a deadline--please write legibly or type the results. Along these same lines, coaches need to take the time to fill out the Team Report they were sent earlier in the season and return it to us. The Team Report will form the base of all the information we print and is very important to our ability to cover track in Oklahoma. Not only does it give us the correct spelling and first names of all the athletes but it allows us to develop a master schedule or meets coming up. It also gives us a contact person and phone number for seeking information when we need it.

The Season Leaders listing has been expanded to ten athletes per event in this issue. I was hoping to be able to do a break down by class but a lack of class A and B results has stymied efforts to get this done for this issue--look for it in the next issue. While I'm on the subject of the Season Leaders: all the times/distances used reflect the time/distance of the finals. Preliminary times are not considered (though they are interesting to know) and should not be listed by coaches who are submitting their own athletes' top performances. I like to hear from anyone who has some input on these listings, whether coach, parent or fan. Feel free to call or FAX information at any time. If your local newspaper is interested in using this listing they are free to do so if they will simply give us a credit line.

The team rankings found elsewhere in this issue were taken from the rankings developed by the regional assignment committee. They will be updated by us for the next issue with all competition taken into account. Again, any input is welcome and if you think your team has not been ranked where they should be, please let us know. Fortunately, track is one of those sports where rankings are merely something to keep interest up during the middle of the season. In the end, the athletes and teams will determine the final outcome.

The first issue of Oklahoma TRACK & FIELD NEWS was sent to every coach in the state and several hundred copies were distributed at a few meets over the past two weeks (Keep your copy--it may be a collector's item someday). This issue is being mailed only to those who have taken a subscription. I hope you will encourage your fellow coaches, friends, parents, athletes, librarians, etc. to take out a subscription. The unanimous comment has been that the State of Oklahoma really needs a publication like this but is only possible if everyone interested in track and cross country supports it by getting a subscription. We also plan to start running advertising as soon as we get time to contact those who might be interested. If you know of any business that might be interested in reaching the track/cross country market in Oklahoma, please let them know about us and let us know about them.



Burns, a sophomore and defending 5A state champion, won the 100m hurdles with a time of 15.05. Washington teammate and 1991 state winner, Kim Motley, also ran in the finals but slipped at the seventh hurdle and did not finish the race.
