

# 1997 High School Track Preview 2A-A-B

It's spring in Oklahoma, at least for the last few days, but there still haven't been very many meets yet, and, as usual, it is pretty hard to get a picture of team strengths. Small schools don't start competing in earnest until all the state basketball tournaments are over and, again unfortunately, they aren't very good about sending in their TEAM REPORTS. Oh, well, it's that broken record again. Anyway, I've had some extra help this year and I'm looking forward to being a little more on top of the small school scene.

#### B Boys

Defending champion Hydro just gets stronger, returning their whole team, with another year's experience. This is always a tight race with the points spread around over four or five teamsless than 20 points separated the top four last year.

Hydro took the state cross country title this year and are led by triple winner Walt Ginn (800/1600/3200), who scored 34 points himself. Beaver was third last year and will look to be in the hunt again this year along with Cherokee, Medford and Waynoka.

Pond Creek-Hunter returns discus champ Josh McReynolds and the Waynoka 400 relay championship team comes back intact.

#### **B** Girls

Texhoma (with Goodwell last year) was the pre-season favorite last year and they came through in the clutch, taking the title by 27 points over runnerup Pond Creek-Hunter. The Red Devils were hurt a bunch by graduation, losing five state meet point scorers, so the Panthers are looking good to ascend to the top of the heap in this class.

Temple, Cherokee, Beaver and Texhoma round out the top five with it just about anyone's guess in what order.

Returning champions include Verdigris high jumper Brandy Willis and Fox's 200 meter champ, Cameko Tyner.

### A Boys

Two-time defending champion Turpin returns a strong cast of sprinters led by Carlos Salazar and will be strong in all three relays. Overall, the Cardinals will be tough to dethrone. Velma-

As usual, spring breaks, weather and basketball have gotten in the way of the start of track but it won't be long before the season is in full swing.

By the way...this issue marks the fifth anniversary of the beginning of the Oklahoma TRACK & FIELD NEWS, it sure doesn't seem like it's been that long...Oh, well...

I'm starting a new method of listing season leaders in this issue and I hope you'll bear with me while I get the kinks worked out. Basically, this new format helps me sort the listings more accurately and, I think, makes it more readable. I'm still working on standardizing my school abbreviations so don't be alarmed by the inconsistencies--I'm also open to suggestions if you don't like the abbreviation I've chosen for your school. To refresh everyone's memory on the parameters for the rankings: in order to be included, the full results of the meet have to be reported to us in order to be considered. This issue only has an overall listing but we should be able to break it down by class in the next issue. At that point, team rankings will be drawn from how the individual listings point out-I hope.

Last year these rankings covered almost 1,000 athletes in seven listings with over 8,000 placewinner's names in the biggest issue. The season leader listings and team rankings are available by FAX to your local newspaper as long as they have a subscription. If you would like to see them in your hometown rag, ask them to give us a call.

I got two responses to the query in the last issue about state championship girls teams with only four point scorers. Wynnewood coach Charles Butler let us know that his girls did it in 1993 and Daniel Webber, a Watonga subscriber, remembers a Dover team that won the championship in about 1987. Any more?

TEAM OKLAHOMA, the new master's running club, has sent out four scholarship vouchers to Oklahoma running clubs and the Oklahoma Track Coaches Association. The vouchers are to be used for youth scholarships to summer running camps. What a great project! Funds for the scholarships are raised through sales of George Hall's Best Performance book--watch these pages for your opportunity to buy one.

The next issue will be dated March 28 and will be the last issue out before regional assignments are made. If you want to have an impact on those assignments, you need to make sure that all meets you attend are reported--promptly and completely--and you need to contact your representative on the coaches' advisory committee listed at the bottom right hand of this page. We will publish regional assignments in the April 11 issue--if the OSSAA has them done.

Alma returns 3200 meter champ Mylo Miller along with a strong set of sprinters and relays. Tonkawa is led by defending pole vault champ, Zac Swords, who is joined by a bevy of talent in the field events and strengths in all three relays.

Heritage Hall, who drops from 2A, is a darkhorse. The Chargers have a wealth of talent in both distance and relays and will be led by seniors Sean Strickland and Blake Pardue.

Oklahoma Christian returns double sprint winner, Jabori Wamble and Foyil's 1600 meter champ, Jason McDonald is back as well.

#### A Girls

This is another class that will be up for grabs. Defending champion Laverne will have their hands full with Boise City, Hollis and Velma-Alma, though the Comets lost mega-point getter, Mandy Sims, to graduation. Luther has triple winner--and just a sophomore--Teya Gill (100/200/LJ) and could be a top five threat if they could find a way to add some more points.

Wamer brings back double winner Miley Turnbull (1600/3200) and Velma-Alma returns sophomore Rae Ann McCurry, 800 meter champ and winner of the cross country title last fall.

Tonkawa returns high jump champ Angela Ogle.

#### 2A Boys

Defending champion Wynnewood--last year's pre-season pick--was wounded seriously by graduation but runnerup Stroud returns over 56 state meet points from the only returning state champions--Jeremie Niccum (1600) Dominique Hombeck (110H) and Kyle Bookout (discus). The Tigers are always tough and this looks like it might be their year.


Prague and Tishomingo had strong showings in the indoor and Watonga looks to be a contender again as well, finishing third in the indoor. Chandler is down from 3A this year and will be led by '95 triple winner (800/1600/3200) and '96 3200 meter winner Bobby Holmes. Plainview, fourth in 3A last year, is also down to 2A and, though seriously depleted by graduation, is always a team in the hunt for a top ten spot.

#### 2A Girls

Defending champion Watonga returns over 68 points from last year's squad and looks to be a good bet to return to the throne. But wait a minute. Perennial 3A power Plainview is down to 2A this year and the Indians have a tough and well-balanced team. Plainview looked strong in winning the indoor meet.

Last year's runnerup, Pawnee, lost heavily to graduation including triple gold winner, Missy Dufrain.

Watonga will be led by returning 100 hurdle champ, Kacy Duffy, who also placed second in the 300 hurdles. Chandler is down to 2A this year and will be a good bet to join Jones, Stroud along with Watonga and Plainview in the top five. There were a bunch of question marks on returning champs in this division but we'll just have to wait until the season gets rolling to see who all is back.







# Coaches Corner


