

# On Track

This issue covers the results of the small school state meets at OU and UCO, May 7-8, and all the regionals. We had trouble getting complete results from some of the 4A-5A regionals as well as a list of the additional qualifiers but at press time we were working on getting it in. The next issue will be dated May 31 and will cover the 4A-5A state meets, the All-Star meet and the Great Southwest Classic.

There were two state records set at the Catoosa regional by Jenks runners Atalie Barber and Emily Waibel. Barber broke teammate Kelli O'Rourke's 1998 800 meter record with a 2:13.47 while Waibel lowered the 100 hurdle mark to 13.61, eclipsing the 1989 mark of 13.81 by John Marshall's Thelma Franks. Both times were FAT (electronic timing) though both are listed a bit faster in the regional results as hand times. I know it gets confusing but both systems were in operation at Catoosa even though the hand times were the ones published. At the Class B state meet Cherokee shot putter Barbara Phillips set a new record of 44-1.5, breaking the 1989 mark of 44-10.5 held by Del City's Carla Austain.

The weather was great for the whole weekend of the small school meets and there were 16 meet records broken or tied. Hopefully, we'll have the same kind of weather in Ardmore for the 4A-5A state meets.

The East-West All-Star meet is scheduled for Saturday, May 22 at the John Jacobs track in Norman at the University of Oklahoma. This is a great opportunity to watch our senior athletes in one more competition. Coaches are Jim Nugent, Del City and Barry Blagowsky, Guthrie, for the West and Roosevelt Kent, Broken Arrow, and Roger Brown, Rogers, for the East. It is still not too late to nominate a senior if you have one interested in competing.

Oklahoma will again be sending a full team to the Great Southwest Classic in Tempe, Arizona at Arizona State, May 29. Our intrepid photographer, Roger Taylor, will be attending and we will hold the last issue for results and photos. Coaches for the Oklahoma team, sponsored by the Oklahoma Track Coaches Association, are Charlie Anderson, Grove (boys) and Terry Martin, Prague (girls).

# 1999 3A-2A-A-B State Track Meets

Even after the big guns of classes 5A and 4A cease firing at this week's final session of the 1999 Oklahoma High School track and field championships, the highlight of the season likely will be the state record toss by a junior shot putter from Cherokee.

Barbara Phillips broke the 10-year-old state record by exactly an inch with a heave of 44-11.5 in the Class B state meet at the University of Central Oklahoma. The former record-holder was Carla Austain of Del City, who died of an asthma attack a few years after her feat.

Rare is it that Class B athletes, the smallest enrollment division in Oklahoma, set over-all state records. No other Class B performer presently holds a state record. The last one who did was Greg Seay of Ryan who was the boys high jump record-holder from 1977 to 1995.

In all, 16 state meet class records were toppled and another one tied during the 3A, 2A, A and B show-downs and three names

were added to the short list of competitors who have swept an event four years in a row.

Mylo Miller of Velma-Alma became only the fifth boy in the 93-year history of Oklahoma state track meets to win a single event four times when he again captured the 3200 in Class A.

Added to the girls four-peat list, now numbering 21, were Warner's Miley Turnbull in the Class 2A 1600 and Cameko Tyner of Fox in the Class B 200.

## 3A Boys

Hang around long enough in the upper echelon of a sport and you're likely to succeed. Elk City is proof of that as it blocked McGuinness' bid for a third straight championship and won the first one of its own by a margin of 106-98.

Mark Heard's Elks were runners-up to Idabel in 1987 and 1990 and to McGuinness last year.

The '87 loss was especially galling. Elk City thought it had edged Idabel, 78-77, by finishing third in the concluding 1600 relay while Idabel came in fifth in that race. But several minutes later, fourth-place Millwood was disqualified for tossing a baton which interfered with a trailing team.

Idabel was moved up to fourth place in the relay and the additional four points gave the Warriors their 11th state title in 13 years.

Appropriately, Elk City's 1999 championship was boosted by what Heard's teams always do better than anyone else: pole vault. Austin Landreth repeated as vault champion at 14-0 and the brown-shirts also had the third and fifth placers for 18 points in the event.

Elk City has produced nine of the last 13 Class 3A pole vault champions — Jeff Bray (87, 89), Ryan Jones (92), Jarrod Heard (94, 95, 96), Heath Payton (97) and Landreth (98, 99).

Another Landreth, Josh, won his second state 400 title for Elk City, but at 48.90 fell shy of his 1998 meet record run of 47.56. Landreth also anchored the 3200 relay, wiping out a 50 meter deficit after getting the baton to give the Elks a healthy 20 points in the meet's first running event.

Certain folks in 3A are downright pigish. Four of them were double winners, headed by McGuinness senior distance runner Kevin Connolly and Weatherford junior weightman Wes Sims.

Connolly swept the 1600 and 3200 for the third straight year, although as a sophomore the double came in Class 4A. He's had better times than this year's 4:26.49 and 10:04.32 and, in fact, is the 3A meet record holder in the latter at 9:24.47. The Irish runner

also garnered three titles in cross country, only the second state runner to accomplish that feat.

In the past, Sims has found Elk City's Charlie Atteberry too much to handle at the state meet, but not this time. The 6-5, 305-pounder shattered Atteberry's 3A discus mark by almost seven feet with a cast of 180-3 and made the Elk senior settle for second in the shot, too — 58-7 to 52-5.5.

Atteberry had nicked Sims, 184-0 to 183-2, in the regional and, "yeah, I wanted revenge," said Sims. The reversal was hardly unexpected as Sims swept both events from Atteberry at the late-season Weatherford Invitational, including a shot toss of 61-0. Sims' discus throw was the only new 3A boys record.

Other hogs were Larron Alexander of Bristow, a quadruple gold medal winner, taking both sprints in 10.78 and 22.17 and running on the winning 400 and 1600 relays, and hurdler Jason Maloy of Kingfisher, who clocked 14.75 and 39.53. Maloy won the intermediates last year and was second in the highs to Brontez Steele of Spiro, who moved down to 2A this season and won there also.

Anadarko half-miler Dustin Moore ran the 800 in 2:02.95 in the regional and was one of the

fourth-place add-ons for the state meet. After apparent winner Lyle Washington of Cushing was disqualified he took home the gold medal with a time of 1:58.33.

Michael Enoch of McGuinness came close to the long jump record by Marlow's Joe Dial (23-5 in 1981) by sailing 23-3.25 and in the process beat defending champ Romar Crenshaw of Broken Bow.

#### 2A Boys

It was speed against speed, Millwood against Spiro. Neither one won. Or, they both won.

When it was over, the Falcons and bulldogs had 64 points each and the state meet had its 10th set of co-champions since the OSSAA began officially conducting meets in 1944.

Oddly, it's Spiro's second title tie.

The co-champions:

Boys — 1953 Purcell and Riverside (B), 1961 McAlester and Pauls Valley (A), 1979 Edmond and B.T. Washington (4A), 1979 Idabel and Spiro (2A), 1991 Balko and Covington-Douglas (B), 1999 Millwood and Spiro (2A).

Girls — 1976 Anadarko and Kingfisher (2A), 1980 Clinton and Vinita (2A), 1990 Plainview and Vian (2A), 1990 Beaver and Hennessey (A).

Spiro, which also won unshared titles in 1977 and 1978, produced four individual champions for coach Chris Burch. Chris Massey won the 100, Jerrod Johnson the 400 and Brontez Steele both hurdles. Johnson set one of 2A's two new meet marks with a 48.32 as he relegated defending champion Roosevelt Littlejohn of Alva to second place.

James Powell of Nowata had held the former 400 record of 48.82 for 10 years.

Millwood made the greatest improvement of any of the 1999 champions in winning its first title. The Falcons finished 12th last season with 19 state meet points.

Coach Don Willis had an individual champion in Kerry Robertson (200) and Millwood took its biggest step toward victory with a 43.25 winning burst by the 400 relay team.


Every Millwood and Spiro point came from seven events — the 100, 200, 400, 110 and 300 hurdles and 400 and 1600 relays.

The other 2A record-setter has the rather familiar name of Bookout.

Kevin Bookout, following the well-trod path of brothers Casey and Kyle, swept the shot and discus, although he's only a freshman, a wee lad of 6-7 and 235. His 60-4 in the shot rubbed out Casey's four-year-old meet mark of 57-7.

fared poorly. Jason DiMauro of Victory Christian, the 1998 winner and meet record holder of the two distance races, ran second to Coleman in the 1600 and to Alva's Ryan Bickerstaff in the 3200. Bickerstaff also outlasted Chisholm's Steve Sawyer, a cross country state champ last fall, who wound up third.

Other beaten defending champions were hurdlers Jarrod Roach or Watonga and Justin Hatfield of Tishomingo, both third behind Spiro's Steele.

#### A Boys

While Turpin was squeezing to a fourth championships in five years (missing in '97), individual heroics were occurring all over the lot.

Among the attention-grabbers were Joey Swallow, Mylo Miller, Travis Stout, Chay Nease and Justin Pitchford.

We'll look at Swallow first since, at 6-4 and who-knows, the Laverne senior is hard to overlook. He finishes his prep career with three consecutive shot and discus titles.

Swallow capped it all by breaking his own meet discus record, set last year, extending it from 179-4 to 183-2. As a freshman, he medaled in both events, second in the discus, fourth in the shot.

Miller, the senior distance ace from Velma-Alma, ran his individual state title collection to eight. He has won the 3200 four straight years, nabbed the 1600 the last two and took cross country crowns as a freshman and a senior.

Stout typifies what Turpin coach Denny Harrel meant when he said, "Everyone scratched for what we needed." Stout, chiefly a hurdler, was a pickup in the long jump after finishing fourth in the regional with an unimpressive 19-3.5.

But at State, Stout took an early lead in the long jump, only to fall to third with one leap left. He proceeded to sail 22-8.25 to shatter the 14-year-old meet mark of Pocola's Bill Brake (22-1.5), which was tied in 1988 by Doug Butler of Hollis.

Two other long jumpers also exceeded the old record — Chris Culpepper of Hollis (22-7), who was the defending champion, and Okfaha's Brent Morgan (22-1.75).

Nease kept Thomas in the running against Turpin, collecting four gold medals, sweeping the 100 and 200 in 11.08 and 21.85 and running on the winning 400 and 1600 relays. He'd won the 200 last year.

At the finish, it was Turpin 96 and Thomas 86.

That meant Stout's 10-point contribution in the long jump was important. However, Thomas also turned a regional fourth-place finish to its advantage when the 3200 relay team knocked 15 seconds off its regional time to finish third and bag 12 points.

Pitchford, a Hinton freshman, stunned the finest 800 runner in Class A history with a 1:56.26 title clocking. Tyson Trimble of Commerce was going for a third straight state victory, but was second in 1:57.91. Trimble had lowered the meet record to 1:55.06 last year.

Reade Box of Mangum concludes with four state pole vault medals — two firsts, a second and a fourth. He won this year and in 1997.

Turpin finished 1-2 in the 400 with Chris Benson unseating 1998 champion Cody Regier.

### B Boys

Boise City scored a title slam in the field events in rolling up an easy triumph over Medford and Beaver, 133 to 74 to 73.

John Terrell, Matt Rosebery and Doug Soell were repeat winners in the shot, high jump and pole vault, respectively. Nolan Randolph won the long jump. Terrell was second in the discus, edged by Beaver's Andy Stone, 155-11 to 152-7, a reversal of their regional finish at Woodward.

Rosebery cleared 6-8, but he's in the class where Greg Seay of Ryan used to excel, so the meet record is 6-11.

Boise City's 1600 relay team also rubbed out a long-standing meet mark with a 3:25.11. Pernell did 3:27.00 in 1984. Also on coach Curt Janko's two relay units were Soell and Jesse Walker.

There were two double winners. Nick Cates of Tyrone won the 1600 and

3200 and Garret Harlan of Texhoma sped away in the 100 and 200.

Nathan Gonzales of Medford repeated his 1998 victory in the 400.

Boise City needed the championship to keep pace with its girls squad. Each has won five titles — the boys in 69, 89, 97, 98, and 99; the girls in 87, 96, 97, 98 and 99.

### 3A Girls

Winning three relays and placing third in the other, McGuinness turned what figured to be a tough title fight with Plainview into a runaway.

The Lady Irish, under the direction this year of Trevor Swink, won their second consecutive state championship and fourth since 1989 by 71 points, 149-78.

Plainview produced the individual standout in freshman distance runner Jesse Gordon. She accounted for 34 points by winning the 800, 1600 and 3200 and running a leg on the second place 3200 relay team. She was also the 3A cross country champion last fall.

In the 3,200, Gordon ran eight seconds under the meet record of 11:21.47 that Katy McGraw of Cascia Hall set in 1997 with an 11:12.99. Defending champion and over-all state record-holder Amanda Jordan of McGuinness was second at 11:23.95.

Gordon did 2:19.16 in the 800 and 5:15.46 in the 1600, also defeating two defending champions Jamie Lucero of Guymon (800) and Jordan (1600). Maggie Kelley of McGuinness also beat Jordan and, at 5:15.75, was just a step behind Gordon.

The two McGuinness distance aces were joined by Tiffany Porte and Christy Rogge in knocking almost 10 seconds off Marlow's year-old meet record in the 3200 relay. The Irish crew posted 9:35.48.

If Plainview had any hope of keeping up with McGuinness, it went down the tube on a disqualification in the 800 relay.

Double victories were achieved by Shannan Hawes of Sallisaw in the 100 and

200, with the latter a title repeat, and by Dana Schafer of Sulphur in the weights. The 128-0 discus throw was more than nine feet beyond her winning effort of a year ago and in the shot she dethroned 1998 champion Jamie Hawkins of Bristow.

Kelsey Strecker of McGuinness improved her winning long jump effort from last year's 17-3.25 to this year's 18-6.25. She also ran legs on the winning 800 and 1600 relays.

Although saved until the last, perhaps the big story in 3A girls was provided by Brandie Willis of Oologah.


As a freshman, Willis attended Verdigris and won the state Class B high jump championship by clearing 5-2. At Oologah the past two seasons, Willis placed third in 1997 at 5-2 and second in 1998 at 5-3.

At the Vinita regional, Brandie managed just 5-0 and made the state field as a fourth-place qualifier. The Vinita meet was won by Mannford's Kristin Rogers, a three-time state champion.

Last Saturday at OU, Willis was the only jumper to clear 5-4. The other five girls to score

points all failed after 5-2, including Rogers, who on most misses, wound up sixth and thus was denied a fourth straight state title.

#### 2A Girls

Miley Turnbull keyed Warner's drive to a repeat championship by winning the 800 and 1600 and anchoring the winning 3200 relay team and third-place 1600 unit.

In the process, Miss

completed a four-year slam of the 1600 and claimed a third consecutive 800 title. As a freshman, she was nipped by less than two seconds in the 800 by another frosh, Rae Ann McCurry of Velma-Alma, or she'd now have four of those gold medals as well.

Turnbull won her first state cross-country title last fall.

Misty Kokojan of Chisholm was bumped to second place in last year's high jump on fewest misses while tying at 5-4. This time, she won the tie breaker from Alva's Kara Hem while again clearing 5-4.

Wynnewood won the two short relays, but could only muster 22 individual points to finish fourth at 62.

#### A Girls

Jerry Loveall's Velma-Alma Comets streaked as all good comets should, scoring the biggest runaway triumph of all the nine new team champions. They won six events and scored in 11 to roll up 112 points.

Thomas and Turpin tied for second place with 48. It was reminiscent of last fall's cross-country romp when V-A tallied 27 points to 72 by runnerup Canton.

Senior Rae Ann McCurry, winding up four banner years, led the way. She won the 1600, the 3200 in meet record time, was fifth in the 800 and ran on the second place 3200 relay unit.

McCurry finishes with seven individual state gold medals, one in the 3200 and two each in the 800, 1600 and cross-country. A 12:03.9 in this year's 3,200 marked the first time she's run that event at State and rubbed out the former re-

Barnwell also got a repeat triumph from senior Tiffany Fox in the 300 hurdles as the Eagles (85 points) held off Lexington (74) and Chisholm (72) in the team race.

Holly Herrmann of Chandler pulled off the only double success other than Turnbull by taking the 100 and 200. She bested defending champion Amanda Wedel of Lexington in the 200.

Wedel, however, retained her 400 crown, winning that event for the third straight year.

Two other 1998 champions were unseated, Lindsay Hicks of Dickson in the 3,200 and Erin Cross of Chandler in the high hurdles. Replacing them were Starlena Gruver of Jones and Nikkie Thomas of Valliant.

cord of 12:04.42, set by Tipton's Rosemary Sierra in 1985.

Not far behind as V-A title contributors were Courtney Chapman, who won the two weight events and, how's this?... ran a leg on the winning sprint relay team, and Tina Lamb, who placed first and second in the hurdles. Both are sophomores.

Non-seniors accounted for 81 of Velma-Alma's 112 points.

Anita Hernandez of Talihina and Tia Smith of Crescent put their names in the record book. Hernandez' 57.95 in the 400 toppled the old mark of 59.10 by Luther's Teya Gill in 1996. Smith tied Kelly Albright's 5-7 high jump for Medford in 1983.

Hernandez beat defending champion Keyonna Hombuckle of Tonkawa in the 400, but Hombuckle came back to win the 800.

Jorinda Griffin of Waurika repeated her 1998 success in the 100, but numerous others did not defend.

The 1600 was a loaded event with three former champions in the field. McCurry had won in '97, but was beaten by Ashley Roberts of Quinton last year. Sarah Turner moved up from Class B where she won last season.

Roberts and Turner also had previous 3200 titles to their credit, but couldn't keep up with McCurry.

Tiffany Carey of Luther kept V-A's Lamb from repeating in the 300 hurdles.

#### B Girls

Barbara Phillips provided the big story with her state record 44-11. A shot put in a meet which saw Boise City pushed by Beaver, 99-90, in winning its third team title in a row.

Phillips, a junior from Cherokee, comes by her shot talent naturally. Her mother, then Gisela Otis, competed for West Germany in the 1972 Munich Olympics.

Gisela, throwing the 4-kilo shot like Barbara, didn't place at Munich. Her career best of 62-9 would have won gold at every Olympics from London 1948 to Tokyo 1964, but it would have been only fifth best at Munich where the winning heave was a world record 69 feet.

"I think my form is a little better than my mom's now," Phillips said. "I think in college I'll throw probably as good as she did."

In addition to cracking the over-all state record by an inch, Phillips smashed the meet record of 40-11 that Jamie Buck, also of Cherokee, set in 1997. Phillips threw 40-9 to win last year's title.

The discus also provided a good twist when senior Caley Gregg of Beaver unleashed a 137-1 fling to top her sister's record of 132-0. Megan Gregg set that in 1995. Caley was the '98 champ at 116-4.

Two other meet records were broken, both by swift senior Cameko Tyner of Fox. In each case, Tyner bettered a record she already owned, taking the 100 from 12.31 to 12.10 and the 200 from 25.42 to 24.62.

Cameko is now a four-time champion in the 200 and has won the 100 the past three springs.

The only other double winner in B girls was Beth Hooten of Canton in the 800 and 1600. She can run farther than that as proven by her title in last fall's Class A cross country meet.

Boise City, coached by Mike Jinkens, picked up 68 relay points by winning the 400 and 800 and placing second and third in the others. The only Wildcat individual winner was Jessi James, whose four-year tally in the 100 hurdles reads fifth, sixth, first, first.




