

State Meet

5A Girls

Midwest City upset Jenks by 10 points, again, to claim the Class 5A state championship at the large school state meet held in Ardmore's Noble Stadium for the second straight year. Coach David Gleason's Bombers scored 106 points to the Trojan's 96 with Edmond North a distant third at 61.

Midwest City benefitted from 36 points in the hurdles, going one-two in both races with sophomore Ryanne Dupree winning both events and adding a runnerup finish in the long jump. She totaled 28 team points herself and would have finished in the top ten teams alone.

Gleason credited his hurdles coach Kenny Redding and jump events coach Tommy Harris. "We had to score big in the hurdles and jumps," Gleason said. "There's a great job of coaching being done here, and it's not me doing it."

The opening event, the 3200 meter relay, came down to a photo finish with Jenks edging Edmond North by 13 hundredths of a second, 9:27.02 - 9:27.15.

The 800 relay was even closer with Broken Arrow edging Midwest City by only one hundredth of a second, 1:43.92 - 1:43.93.

Jenks senior Atalie Barber closed out her stellar career with wins in both the 800 and 1600, setting a new meet record of 5:09.93 in the process. The old record was 5:09.97, set by Union's Michelle Scholtz in 1987. Barber also ran the anchor leg on the winning 3200 relay.

Stillwater's Delisa McLain broke her own meet record in the discus by over four feet with a toss of 143-3, eclipsing her 1999 mark of 138-11.

Choctaw's Leslie Dunlap set the record in the first pole vault event for girls with a leap of 11-0, tops in all the state meets.


5A Boys

Defending champion Jenks went into the meet as an underdog but ended up top dog as coach Steve Patterson's Trojans edged Lawton 86-83 for their second straight Class 5A boys team title. Last year Jenks beat Lawton 73-60 for the title.

The Trojans won only one event, taking the opening 3200 meter relay by an eyelash over Bartlesville with both teams timed in 8:01.27. The team title was in doubt until the final event. Jenks need to place at within two places of Lawton in the 1600 relay to sew up the championship and they did, finishing fourth to Lawton's second.

"We had kids going that mile relay who knew what they needed to do to win," said Patterson. "It was the epitome of a team champion."

Bartlesville's Joey McNair scored more than half of his team's points, taking the 800/1600/3200 triple and running on the second place 3200 relay.

McNair's feat equaled the performance of Edmond Memorial's Mark Thompson who won the same triple in 1997.

Muskogee's Alfred Neale upped the high jump meet record by clearing 7-2, still a bit short of his state record of 7-3.5 set earlier this season.

Edmond Memorial's Kevin Opalka set the only other meet record, breaking the pole vault record by one inch with a leap of 16-1. Owasso's Lamont Moore missed a record by a quarter of an inch, going 24-3.75 in the long jump.

Lawton's Pat Brown was the only other double winner, taking both hurdles events with a 14.15 in the 110 and 37.52 in the 300.

Ardmore won their second straight title in front of the home crowd in Noble Stadium, scoring a whopping 138 points (same story in the boys race) to runnerup McAlester's 76. The Tigers started the final day with a 21-point lead and pulled away behind second-place finishes in the 400 relay, 800 relay, 200, 400, 100 hurdles and the long jump.

Consistent high finishes were the secret to Ardmore's success as they won only two events, the 1600 relay and high jump.

"All those points add up," said coach LeeAnn Musgrove. "That's what counts, and we told them that. They all worked together toward one goal, and they accomplished that."

Tulsa Central's Shana Robinson won the 100/200 double, breaking her own meet record in the 100 with a blazing 11.70. Other double winners were McAlester's Kim Thomas,

800/1600 and Carl Albert's BreeAnna Gibson, shot/discus.

B.T. Washington finished a distant third in the girls race but the foursome of Tatiana Simon, Darnesha Sellers, Yolanda Goff and Tasheena Antwine helped the cause as they set a meet and overall state record in the 800 meter relay with a 1:39.59, breaking John Marshall's 1:39.87 set in 1989.

McAlester had the Nos. 1 and 2 finishers in the 800 with sisters Kim and Michelle Thomas going 2:19.89 and 2:21.53. It was Kim's third straight win in the event.

Claremore's Melissa Turner's winning 9-6 in the pole vault was the new meet record.

4A Boys

Same results, just a different path. The Ardmore boys won six events in amassing their 138 points. The tigers extended their slim 11-point lead over Carl Albert going into Saturday's events, with wins in the 400 relay, 200 (Ataleo Ford), 400 (Jowahn Poteat), 1600 relay, long jump (Jamaal Moore) and high jump (Merril Andrews).


"We're just very fortunate," said coach Chuck Minkley. "We have quality athletes and we were fortunate to put them in the right events to give them the chance to win at state."



Marco Jimenez became the first Capitol Hill winner in 20 years when he took the 3200 in 10:32.56.








CLASS 4A STATE MEET--Edison's Michael Dixon (right) won the 1600 with a time of 4:34. Photo by Roger Taylor


