The annual cross country All-Star meet sponsored by the Oklahoma Track Coaches Association will again be held on the University of Arkansas' course in Fayetteville on Saturday November 13. This year teams from Oklahoma, Kansas, Arkansas and Missouri will compete in what promises to be a real exciting meet.

Coaches for the Oklahoma teams are Mustang's Mike McGarry (boys-405-376-7363 school or 787-2585 home) and McGuinness' David Morton (girls-405-842-6638 school or 341-0877 home). Nominations need to be phoned to either coach by Wednesday, October 27. Only runners whose coaches are members of the OTCA are eligible but all class years can compete. There will be a small participation fee but it will include a uniform. The OK Runner in Norman is the team sponsor and is providing the uniforms.

Rankings in this issue were updated following the 2A-A regional meets last weekend. The 5A-4A-3A rankings were not changed even though there were several meets. The next regular issue will contain full regional results for all classes, 2A-A state meet results and the final 5A-4A-3A team and individual rankings and a preview of the large school state meet at ORU.

U.S.A. Track & Field is sponsoring a Level I Coaching Certification Clinic December 17 & 18 in Austin, Texas. This is a great opportunity for any coach working with young runners to improve their professional standing. This is a two-day course and special arrangements have been made for lodging in the area. 1999 2A-A State Meet Preview

The 1999 Oklahoma Secondary Schools Activities Association's State Cross-Country Championships for small schools (2A) will be held Saturday, October 23, at Shawnee's Gordon Cooper Vo-Tech Campus.

Regional were held at two sites: the north regional at Chisholm and the south regional at Lindsay. The top seven teams from each regional qualified for state in each class, along with the top seven non-team qualifying individuals.

The weather was ideal for running and the competition lived up to its billing. All of the top ranked teams captured their respective regional titles with the closest race coming between class A girls at Lindsay where defending state champ Velma-Alma only beat upstart Sallisaw Central by nine points.

On the individual side of competition, the No. 1 ranked runners were all regional champions with the exception of one. Erin Rooney of Oklahoma Christian upset Carnegie's No. 1 ranked Lucian Bliss at the Lindsay regional.

The final team rankings changed a little but the individual rankings had many changes, especially in class A. Three defending champions enter the state meet ranked No. 1—Jesse Gordon and Patrick McGuire of Plainview and Beth Hooten of Canton with Velma Alma the only one defending team champion entering the fray as the favorite. Chisholm's Steve Sawyer, last year's 2A champion and Carrie McFall

of Cascia Hall, the 3A champion '97 return to state competition.

This is a different format with a separate small school and large state championship, but the competition will be tough and as good as ever, causing the state meet to be a very exciting event. Don't miss it.

2A Girls

This is going to be an exciting race to watch. Class 2A is becoming one of the toughest classes for Oklahoma cross country, both individually and team.

Individually, Plainview sophomore Jesse Gordon will be running for a second consecutive state championship and is undefeated in class competition so far this year. She was the 3 A state champion in '98 and has consistency been one of the top girls in the state regardless of class. She will be pushed by Watonga's Kimbri Lettkeman and Amanda Moore, and

Plainview, with one of the top girls teams in the state, period, should easily win the team title. They cruised to a 22-58 win over Lindsay in the south regional, coming up just one short of a perfect race.

Coach Jerry Naylor's Indians have four runners that are capable of placing in the top five.

Watonga won the north regional, but will be looking over their shoulder trying to hold on for a runner-up finish. The Eagles' Jim Coleman has done an excellent job with this team, but they are young and will be around for awhile. Lindsay is also looking good and will give Watonga a good challenge for the silver. Lexington will wait in the wings to step up if someone stumbles hoping to come away with a state trophy.

by her Plainview teammates Aja Clark, Stephanie Merlin, and Jackie Jones. Cascia Hall's Carrie McFall, the '97 3A state champion can't be counted out, nor should Lexington's Amanda Wedel, who has the 800 meter speed to win the race if she's still around for a sprint.

2A Boys

The final rankings are reversed here with Watonga and Plainview battling it out all season and Watonga winning each time. Both teams ran true to form at the regional with Watonga winning the north over Chisholm and Plainview running to a perfect score of 15 at the south.

This race will probably be decided by the fifth runner, that's how close they have been all year. This will definitely be an exciting race. Watonga keeps the No. 1 ranking but an improving Plainview is looking for their first win over Watonga while Chisholm will be duking it out with an improving young Heritage Hall team for the bronze with Riverside and Dickson both capable of breaking into the trophy category as well.

The individual race could be one of the best of the day. Plainview sophomore Patrick McGuire, last year's 3A state champion, will be

going for his second consecutive state championship. He is undefeated in this class and won the south regional easily. He will be challenged by an improving Ryan Bickerstaff of Alva who won the north regional convincingly over the '98 2A state champion Steve Sawyer of Chisholm and Watonga's Jim Bob Coleman. This will definitely be a tough race and all four of these outstanding runners have a legitimate shot at winning the state title this weekend.

Carnegie has been ranked No. 1 throughout the season and they have continued to improve. They won the south regional convincingly over defending state champion Oklahoma Christian School, 32-57. But, Oklahoma Christian has been improving steadily and could make a real race out of it at state where there will be double the number of runners.

At the north regional, Oklahoma Bible beat Beaver by 25 points and is the best of the rest. Braman, third in the north, Oktaha and Velma-Alma, third and fourth in the south, could also sneak in for a state trophy.


Velma Alma has steadily improved as the season progressed. They won the south regional by a narrow nine points


