

# On Track

There are over 400 schools in Oklahoma with track programs and every one of them should have a subscription for their library. I probably won't have time to get a list published in this issue of who does and who doesn't but all it takes from you is a call to your school librarian to see if they have a subscription. And, if they don't, see to it that they get one, even if it means paying for it yourself.

Speaking of the web site. Most of you have noticed that it now takes a password to gain access to the results, rankings and other stuff posted on the site. Getting a password is simple. If you are a subscriber, simply send a email message to Andre Reddington: [andre@oktrack.com](mailto:andre@oktrack.com). He will send your access information by return email. If you are not a subscriber you don't get access. Simple. We are working to improve the web site with more past results and quicker postings of current results and rankings.

Here's some more beginning of the year stuff.

**RANKINGS** begin in this issue. Please remember that they can only reflect what happened in the previous two weeks with less weight given to prior competition. Also, we can only draw rankings from meets that are reported to us by Monday afternoon. Rankings are again being released to the state papers and put on the web site. If your local newspaper does not run them, ask them to call us.

**RESULTS:** rankings are based on results and unless we receive them we are in the dark. They must be in our office no later than Monday afternoon to be considered for the rankings. Certain parts of the state (Tulsa, NE, Panhandle, SE) are notoriously lax in reporting their meets and it only hurts the runners in those areas. Please encourage all meet directors to report their meets.

**TEAM REPORTS** went out three weeks ago but, as usual, not enough have come back. Coaches, please take the time to fill it out and return it - at least send us a team roster and a schedule.

**PHOTOGRAPHS**—We are blessed with one of the best sports action photographers in the business. Roger Taylor's work has graced these pages for year and readers can buy the photos for their own collections, including many that do not make the magazine. Give Roger a call at 405-341-3171.

# Six Defending Champions Return to Defend Titles

Six of the 10 1999 Cross Country State Champions and one former champions will return this year led by McGuinness senior Amanda Jordan who will be gunning to become only the second runner in state history to claim four state titles. Jordan, the state record holder in both the 1600 and 3200 meter runs, has not had a serious challenge in her past three championship races and there doesn't appear to be one on the horizon for this year. The only Oklahoma runner to accomplish the four-peat was Cascia Hall's Natalie Gray, who won her titles between 1990 and 1993.

Three other runners will be going for their third title: Plainview juniors Patrick McGuire and Jessie Gordon and Canton junior Beth Hooten. In all, 63 All-State placemen will be back to compete this

season. A little over 200 schools sponsor cross country teams though many have just a few individual runners.

Other defending champions are Jenks sophomore Brianna McLeod (5A) and Elk City senior Travis Johnson whose teammate Chris McHone was the 1998 champ.

Little 2A Plainview girls sit atop the Power Ranking which combines all classes. Gordon and Jordan are the state's top two runners and will likely only meet once this season and that will be in Dallas September 16 at the Southern Methodist University meet. Edmond Memorial tops the boys Power Ranking.

The state meets will again be held at two different locations one week apart. This year, 3A is going to drop back a week to run with 2A and A at the Gordon Cooper Vo-Tech in Shawnee on October 21 while 5A and 4A will go on October 28 at Oral Roberts University in Tulsa.

Here is a preview of what to expect.

## 5A Boys

Defending champion Edmond Memorial will be gunning for their 11th state title under coach Dave Sammons. The Bulldogs will back a stiff challenge from cross-state rival Jenks, reviving their fierce competitions of the 80's.

Edmond Memorial's Marc Shumate gets the top ranking at this point with Jenks' Remington Moll No. 2. Jenks' Chase Hall, Union's Landon Willets are at Nos. 3 and 4. Bartlesville's Blake Culp is the highest returning finisher, with nine of the top 15 returning to competition this year.

## 5A Girls

Defending champion Jenks will be favored to give coach Martha O'Rourke her second state title after capturing her first last year. The Trojans will face tough challenges from Westmoore and Mustang.

Jenks sophomore McLeod leads the individuals with eight of the top 15 back in competition again this year. Other individuals to watch are

Ponca City's Chelsie Baldwin, Owasso's Jamie German, Edmond North's Andrea Hurley and Jenks' Megan Burns.

## 4A Boys

This could be the year that parity comes to 4A. McGuinness, winner of five straight titles and seven in the last eight years, is not ranked No. 1. Duncan gets the nod at the moment but a strong group of schools including Guthrie, Capitol Hill, Kelley and Edison sense an opportunity to unseat the Irish and it will be a while before the picture clears up.

Capitol Hill's Marco Jimenez, second last year, is the top returning placemen but has been invisible so far due to none of his meets being reported. He will certainly be a force to contend with when he lines up for the race. 10 of the top 15 runners return and Edison's Michael Dixon gets the No. 1 ranking with Ardmore's Thai Lee, Guthrie's Sterling Pratt, McGuinness' Morgan Snipes and Noble's Cody Weaver all nipping at his heels.

## 4A Girls

In spite of having the No. 1 runner and likely four-time champion, the Irish girls find themselves in much the same boat as they boys. Lucky for them there don't seem to be the challengers around to unseat them and they seem headed for a record ninth championship in a row. Hoping to spoil the party will be Kelley, Grove and Weatherford.

With Jordan off the front the race will be hot for the remaining All-State slots. Weatherford's Holly Villines, Guthrie's Jamie Theobald and Altus' Linda Vasquez and Allison Carney will be top contenders.

## 3A Boys

Elk City hopes to add another boys title to the three they already have as coach Mark Heard's team stands at the head of the pack being chased by defending champion Little Axe, perennial contenders Marlow and Anadarko.





Jhavarr Swift, Little Axe's Chris Orsban and Tuttle's Billy Baynum hot in pursuit.

### 3A Girls

Elk City is the defending champ here after grabbing their first girls title last year and the Elks look to hang onto the title again this year. Of course, Marlow, Edmond Deer Creek and Anadarko have other ideas.

Marlow's Chandra Huckaby gets the No. 1 slot followed by Elk City's Ashley Brimage and She Johnson, Elgin's Nancy Owens and Cache's Brook Estevez. Eight of the top 15 finishers return to compete again this year.

### 2A Boys

Defending champion Plainview edged Watonga 32-49 last year for the championship, their first win over Watonga for the season. The Indians get the nod for the No. 1 slot but watch for some serious competition for the championship again this year for Watonga, Heritage Hall and Chisholm.

Indian junior Patrick McGuire is one of the top boys in the state regardless of class and he is likely to grab his third title, setting himself up for becoming another four-timer along with Gordon next year. Stroud's Travis Pearman, Plainview's Matt Stewart and Randy Womack and Watonga's Marshal Medicine Bear round out the top five. Ten of the top 15 runners return to competition this year.

### 2A Girls

With Plainview on another planet this class has to be satisfied with gunning for the leftovers. The Indians have a chance of grabbing six of the top ten slots with Watonga leading Lexington, Tishomingo, and Chisholm in the race for the silver.

Gordon is not unbeatable and she had some good races with Watonga sophomore Kimbri Lettkeman last year. Watch for more of the same this year with teammates Aja Clark and Jacie Jones joined by Watonga's Amanda Moore in the top five rankings right now. Ten of the top 15 runners return here too.

### A Boys

Defending champion Carnegie aims to repeat after capping an outstanding season last year with a 26-72 with over Oklahoma Bible Academy. Oklahoma Christian School and Velma-Alma will try to make it otherwise.

Oklahoma Christian's Erin Rooney gets the No. 1 slot with Carnegie's Carlos LaBrada and Trevor Beaver, Hooker's Luke Voth and teammate Steve May rounding out the top five. Ten of the top 15 runners return.

### A Girls

Defending champion Canton is led by two-time champ Beth Hooten but Carnegie's Kishia Sharp gets the No. 1 ranking right now. 13 of the top 15 girls return with Oklahoma Bible's Melissa Dell and Heidi Schmidt, Woodland's McKale Davis, and Hooten making up the top five. Carnegie, Hooker and Velma-Alma will be pushing to claim one of the top trophies.












