

# On Track

This is it. This is the last issue of *Oklahoma Track Field News*. For the past nine track seasons and eight cross country seasons we've brought the results, photos and news of Oklahoma's talented young athletes to these pages but it will be no more.

In 1993 McGuinness High School coach David Morton suggested that I start up a publication like this, patterned after my main publication, *Amateur Wrestling News*. My daughter Jessica was a freshman and had won the state championship the previous fall in cross country and my other daughter Connor was running on the junior high team. It seemed a logical progression for me. My father, a track athlete, founded *Amateur Wrestling News* in 1955 when the wrestling coach at Michigan State University suggested it as a way for him to keep track of his four wrestling sons that were in school there. So, it was natural to complete the circle with a wrestler starting a publication to keep track of his track daughters.

We had the publishing experience and wheelbase necessary to get *Oklahoma Track & Field News* off the ground (and the web site six years later) and with the support of the Oklahoma Track Coaches Association we managed to keep it going. With some issues running over 40 pages and including the names of thousands of athletes as well as scores of outstanding photos from Roger Taylor (who contributed his work free of charge), it was a labor of love. And, that was OK as long as I had my daughters in school but once they were gone it became necessary for this little publication to pay its own way.

We've had a lot of help, mostly volunteer, from coaches and parents and we never could have done the kind of publication we did without their help. I've tried to communicate the situation for several years now and the response has been gratifying, but just not enough to keep us in business.

What it has boiled down to is the fact that I need someone replace me as the editor. Someone who has a keen interest in track and a strong commitment to our subscribers. We reached 750 subscribers this year, falling short of the goal of 800. However, 800 was only an intermediate goal en route to the necessary 1,000 subscribers it will take to make this a viable business.

I'll leave the door open for someone to come along and revive it but I'm not holding out any serious hope. This is truly disappointing for me and it's been a tough decision. I know that the young athletes of our state deserve a publication like this but I'm just not the one to be the editor.

Goodbye, it's been a great time.

### At Ardmore

#### 5A Girls

The Jenks girls are back on top after a two year reign by Midwest City, who ironically stopped Jenks from a threepeat of their own back in 1999. In the past seven years the Lady Trojans have now collected four titles and two runner-up prizes. This years victory is largely attributed to the help of cross country champion Brianna McLeod. The sophomore swept the three distance events, set two meet records, and one overall state record.

McLeod started the weekend by defending her 2000 win with a meet record of 11:02.10 in the 3200, almost three seconds faster than Tulsa Memorial's Michelle Schultz 11:04.94 set in 1987. The next day she won the 800 in 2:14.89 over teammate Megan Burns who finished in 2:17.49. A few hours later, McLeod lined up for a state record mile. McLeod finished in 5:04.31, taking the title away from Plainview's Jessie Gordon, who set the record last March.

Putnam City freshman Lois Boyd had a relatively big margin of victory in the 100. Two defending champs repeated in the sprints as Broken Arrow's Shameka Holloway beat Jenks' Liz Waibel to the line, and Putnam City North's Ashley Williams cruised in the 400 with a 57.26 win.

It was not a good day meet for returning champs in the field events. Norman's Halee Prickett (shot), Edmond Memorial's Kirbi Wilson (long jump), and Yukon's Kelsey Moore (high jump) all finished in third. Union's Donesha Adams added the long jump gold to her two relays. Edmond Memorial's Lindsay Gannaway improved from her silver to win the high jump, and Amanda Warehime of Bartlesville had a double state meet record performance in the throws. Warehime threw a 46-4.5 in the shot on Friday to lengthen the state record she set at the Frontier Conference meet by another seen inches, the mark also set the meet record formally held by Norman's Candice Palmer at 43-10. On Saturday she came back and set the meet record in the discus with a toss of 143-4 one inch better than Stillwater's Delisa McLain threw last year. State record holder Devon Fox from Norman North claimed the pole vault with a 10-6 clearance.

Midwest City's Ilicia Walker and Hallie Hutchins out of Stillwater traded places with each other in the hurdle events as Walker beat out Hutchins in a, as close as they come 14.86 to 14.87, in the 100 meter hurdles while Hutchins outlasted Walker in the 300 meter version, 45.21 to 45.28.

Second place team Tulsa Union got more than half their points from the two sprint relays, as Donesha Adams, Ashley Pratt, Christy Schultz, and Jenny Schultz made up the winning 400 and 800 meter relay teams.


Last year it took a tense 1600 meter relay to place within two spots of the Lawton foursome to secure Jenks' title defense. It was apparent after the first day of competition that the Trojans' were not going to let that happen again by creating a 53 to 20 cushion over then second place Owasso. After winning the 3200 meter relay with a near "B" team, Chase Hall and Ross Cohlma went 1-2 in the 3200 run, and Scott Martin and Zach Edwards took a gold and bronze in the pole vault giving Jenks their comfortable lead.

Jenks didn't waste any time on day two either. In the second event of the afternoon Rem Moll led the way for teammates Mick Murray (4th) and David McVey (6th) with a sizzling 1:52.87 in the 800. The top six places all came from the Tulsa area as Owasso's Aaron Dittmore was the silver medalist, Union's Landon Willets placed third, and Sand Spring's Marcus Mayes finished fifth.

Moll came back to lead a group of teammates at another win in the 1600. With a time of 4:24.82, Moll edged out Chase Hall who finished in 4:24.96. Tim Forthman finished in sixth place giving the trio nineteen points for the event.

Lawton's Pat Brown repeated his hurdle double, but with faster times this year. After being clocked in 14.15 for the 110's and 37.52 for the 300's, Brown dipped to 14.04 and 37.40. Lawton had to settle for second once again for the team title. The Wolverines accumulated 76 points to outdistance last falls cross country champions Edmond Memorial who scored 44, but did manage to break John Marshall's eleven year old 1600 meter relay record. Made up of Anthony Anderson, Cliff Mitchell, Clint Goodson, and Justin Lee, the Bulldogs completed the four lap event in 3:15.80. John Marshall set the previous record in 1990 with a 3:16.33.

The two other returning champs didn't fare so well. Owasso's Lamont Moore came up a half inch short to Tulsa Memorial's Kendall Davis, and Choctaw's Derek Warehime finished a disappointing fifth in the discus while Edmond North's Evan Helvey took the gold with a 179-5 toss.

Freshman Jaston Flenory took a little pressure off the Ardmore 1600 meter relay team. By capping off her weekend with a silver in the 1600, to go along with her gold in the 800 and bronze in the 3200, Flenory gave the Tigers enough points to secure their third straight team championship, without the often times crucial four lap relay. This time the Tigers outscored Booker T. Washington.

Booker T. Washington went on to win the four by four, to go along with their two other short relay wins, but even if Ardmore somehow didn't score in the meets final event, it would have left the Hornet's three points back.

Ardmore got their only other victory in the 200 by Alicia Officer who finished second in the event last year to meet record holder Shana Robinson from Tulsa Central. Most of the Tiger's points came from the four high placing relays. Lauren Ice chipped in with a silver and bronze in the hurdle events and Sheleatha McGee did the same in the shot and disc..

Claremore's Melissa Turner was the meets lone returning champ. She successfully kept her crown and upped her state meet record to 10-0 in the pole vault.

#### 4A Boys

It seems like they are always either on top or at least in contention. It doesn't seem fair that they get to do it in their own backyard now. On Friday Ardmore scored big in the discus. Philip Tabor, Ryan Stevenson, and Omar Humphrey swept the first three places giving Ardmore 24 of their 40 points from day one. The trio came back the next day and accomplished the same thing in the shot. This time with Stevenson in first with a throw of 54-3. Humphrey and Tabor tied for second at 52-1.5.

Ardmore got more points from the field as Jamael Moore won the long jump for the third year in a row and teammate Wallace Kemp placing fourth to help the Tigers win their eighth championship and fourth straight.

Carl Albert moved up from a third place finish a year ago. The Titans had three finalists in the 200 meter dash, including Robert Jones who also won the 100 earlier in the day. Bryan and Brandon Smith finished fifth and sixth. They were teamed with Marcus Allen to form the winning 400 meter relay that finished in 41.73.

Edison's Michael Dixon repeated in the 1600 with a time of 4:30.42 after winning the 3200 the day before over returning champ Tyler Kelley from Bishop Kelley. Claremore's Steve Elliott also repeated his win from last year in the pole vault.

Jeff Scott managed to win the 110 hurdles over Carl Albert's Kellon Curry, but the Titan freshman came back to beat Scott in the 300 hurdles, an event he won last year.









#### 3A Girls

Quick flash back to four years ago. Freshman Amanda Jordan had just won her first cross country championship and the McGuinness girls had not won a track title since 1990. Since then both have kept winning. Not only has McGuinness won four straight titles, they have won by an average of 64 points.

Jordan capped off her senior year by adding three more gold medals to her collection by doubling in the 1600/3200 and running a leg on the 3200 relay. With the addition of a second place finish in the 800 behind Marlow's Chandra Huckaby, the total track tally for Jordan is seven gold, three silver, and four bronze.

Kelsey Strecker did repeat in the long jump and broke a 26 year old state meet record. Her 18-10.5 broke the former record of 18-8.75 by Denise Hayes of Laverne. Nikki Mancinelli, another Irish team member, defended her title in the high jump.

#### 3A Boys

In what could very easily be considered the best performance of the small school state weekend Elgin's Justin Noble ran away from defending from Lyle Washington from Cushing. Noble crushed Washington's year old state meet record by more than three seconds and ducked under the overall state record with a blazing 1:51.70. The old overall boys record was a 1:52.31 by Midwest City's Chip Helaire.

Pauls Valley won the team title, improving from a fourth place finish last year. The Panthers had commanding victories in both of the short relays, and a pair of double winners in T.J. Rushing (100/200) and Tobias Schilling

(110H/300H). Elgin and Elk City tied for runnerup with 60 points each. Elk City had a 1-2-3 sweep in the pole vault as Austin Landreth managed to win the event for the fourth time. Improving each year, 13-0, 14-0, 14-7, to a 16-0 as a senior.








