



Mid-Season Review

With the small school regionals on tap for the weekend of October 14 the first cross country season of the year 2000 is rapidly drawing to a close. The top teams have all held on to their spots with the exception of 5A boys but the races are certainly beginning to tighten up. Pre-state races at Gordon Cooper Vo-Tech and Oral Roberts University gave a good glimpse of what can be expected when the state meets take place at those sites.

Small school powers Watonga and Plainview still hang on to the top Power Ranking spots with Jenks nipping at their heels in both divisions. The Trojans climbed back into the No. 1 spot with a narrow win over Edmond Memorial in the boys race at ORU while the Trojan girls have held the No. 1 ranking in 5A all season.

Here's a brief review of what's coming and what's happened by class.

A Girls

Oklahoma Bible Academy is having a fantastic season in this division. The tiny little school in Enid has dominated this class and finished a very respectable second to the No. 1 team in the state at the Cowboy Jamboree on September 30 in the 3A-2A-A division. The Trojans didn't even field a complete team at last year's state meet with junior Bethany Sandwick their top finisher, just missing All-State honors by crossing the line in 11th place.

Defending champion Canton doesn't intend to give up the title easy and the Tigers have a pretty serious 1-2 punch with defending champion Beth Hooten and top ranked Nancy Gray. OBA's Melissa Dell and Heidi Schmidt will contend with the Canton girls for the top spots along with Woodland's McKale Davis (7th in '99) and Sallisaw Central's Maranda Ross (9th in '99). Buffalo's Cassie Prophet is ranked No. 7 and finished in 5th last year.

Carnegie heads the best of the rest but in this class it's extremely hard to pick the finish until after the regionals. And, even then, it is still pretty iffy. Oklahoma Christian, Tonkawa and perennial power Velma-Alma will all be in the hunt for some hardware.

A Boys

No, you aren't seeing double. Oklahoma Bible Academy holds down the top spot here as well. The Trojan boys had a great season last year with a regional win and second place to Carnegie at the state meet.

This still has to be rated a toss up though, with Oklahoma Christian and defending champion Carnegie both very capable of being the champion. Saints junior Erin Rooney (second in '99) has held the No. 1 ranking all season with Maysville's Jake Devinney, Velma-Alma's T.C. Green and Carnegie's Trevor Beaver all looking to knock him off.

2A Girls

What can you say. Defending 2A champion Plainview is simply the best team in the

state. Period. Two-time champ Jesse Gordon has missed the last few meets due to some foot problems but she is expected to be back at full speed by the state meet. Her absence hasn't slowed the Indian's down much at all, as they grabbed wins both the Cowboys Jamboree and the pre-state meet at Shawnee.

With six runners ranked in the top ten and all seven in the top 12, the only way the Indians can be beat is if their team bus breaks down on the way to the meet and they don't make it to the starting line. This isn't to say that there isn't any competition here. Watonga definitely has intentions of being the spoiler and they won't take kindly to the previous remark. They are also one of the top ten teams in the state, holding down the No. 10 spot in the Power Ranking. Led by sophomore Kimbri Lettkeman (3rd in '99) and coach Jim Coleman's daughter Heather, the Eagles have an attitude and if the Indians miss a step, they'll be there to take advantage of it.


2A Boys

This is where the other best team in the state resides. The Watonga boys showed up at Edmond's Dog Patch run a couple of weeks ago and embarrassed their hosts by winning the meet. In spite of some whining about the Dogs not having their full team, that feat earned them the top spot in the Power Ranking and so far, no one has taken it away from them. Chisholm has been improving all season and now edges Plainview for the No. 2 spot but this will really be a fight for the silver here as well.

Plainview junior Patrick McGuire is the two-time defending champion and maybe the best runner in any class this year. No one has come close to him in Oklahoma and it would probably take the proverbial train wreck to stop him from being a four-time winner along with his teammate Jesse Gordon. Watonga some serious horse here though, with Marshall MedicineBear, Justin Edsal, Jason Coleman and John Kuehn all holding down the other top five slots.

3A Girls

This race is really up for grabs. Marlow has had the top spot for the past month but you never really know what will happen at state when the chips are down. The Outlaws have always been a tough end-of-the-season team but there are prob-

ably at least three teams in the top ten that could take home the top trophy.

The Outlaw's Chandra Huckabay gets the nod for the No. 1 spot with Jay's Lora Loy, Edmond Deer Creek's Jenna Garrett and Outlaws Ashley Brackeen and Amanda McCauley rounding out the top five.

3A Boys

Elk City can lay claim to another one of the top teams in the state in spite of being snubbed by the Power Ranking. Their boy's team was narrowly defeated by Watonga at OBU (39 - 53) and at the Cowboy Jamboree their comparative times would have been 4th as a team in 5A, and would have won 4A. They defeated Plainview at the Jamboree, the Power Ranking's No. 6 team. Also, according to an Elk booster, "Watonga is a good team but when they beat Memorial at the Dog Pack run the Memorial team was split. The power rankings are fun but I ask you: Who left the Elks out?" I guess I did.

Two Elks stand at the top of the individual heap here with Chris McHone again going into the end of the season with the No. 1 ranking as he did last year only to see teammate Travis Johnson take the win. Anadarko's Jhavarr Swift and Jesus Rubio along with Marlow's Jon Davis and Byng's Ladd Sullins will be vying for the top medals as well.












