ALL-STATE/ SENIOR ALL-STAR POLICIES

OCA ALL-STATE & ALL-STAR

CROSS COUNTRY

Blue & Gold All State Jacket: Athletes finishing in the top ten in the state meet will be considered All State and will be eligible to obtain a blue and gold All State jacket (regardless of classification: freshman, sophomore, junior and senior).

Red & Gold All Star Jacket: Athletes finishing 11th – 15th place at the state meet will be eligible for the red and gold All Star jacket (regardless of classification: freshman, sophomore, junior and senior).

TRACK & FIELD

Blue & Gold All State Jacket: The OCA recognizes those athletes who finish first (regardless of classification: freshman, sophomore, junior and senior) eligible to receive the Blue & Gold All State jacket.

Red & Gold All Star Jacket: The OCA recognizes those athletes who finish second and third place in their respective events (regardless of classification: freshman, sophomore, junior and senior) as All Star and are eligible to receive the Red & Gold jacket.

OCCTCA SENIOR ALL-STAR

OCCTCA ALL-STAR

Red & Gold All Star Jacket: Athletes selected by the OCCTCA will be eligible to obtain an All-Star jacket, state patch must be embroidered with the following: "OCCTCA SR ALL-STAR".

Athlete's coach MUST be an OCCTCA member to be eligible.

The OCCTCA is not responsible for incorrect student classifications on state meet results.

CROSS COUNTRY

OCCTCA recognizes the top 15 finishing seniors at each respective State Championship, not earning All-State honors.

TRACK & FIELD

OCCTCA recognizes the top scoring (top 8 finish) senior per individual event at each respective State Championship, who did not win that event (state patch must be embroidered with the following: "OCCTCA SR ALL-STAR"). No recipients will be awarded in events absent of Seniors.
