- \*Middle school open and elementary division will be untimed (a running clock will be provided but coaches will be responsible for times)

**Awards:** 1st place team trophy in all high school and middle school varsity races. Individual OSU Pistol Pete medals awarded to top 30 in high school varsity and JV races. Medals awarded to top 30 in middle school varsity and middle school open races. Ribbons awarded to all finishers in the elementary school open division.

8 runners allowed in high school varsity divisions. (Score 5, 2 displacers.)

Teams with 5 runners <u>must</u> register in varsity division.

Out-of-state schools with enrollment of 630 or more students <u>must</u> register in the 6A/5A Large School division.

Limit of 20 runners per team in JV divisions

No club teams. School teams must be NFHS affiliated.

No unattached runners (individual runners **must** be affiliated with their school team).

Only school coaches may register runners

No registration necessary for Middle School Open and Elementary Races
