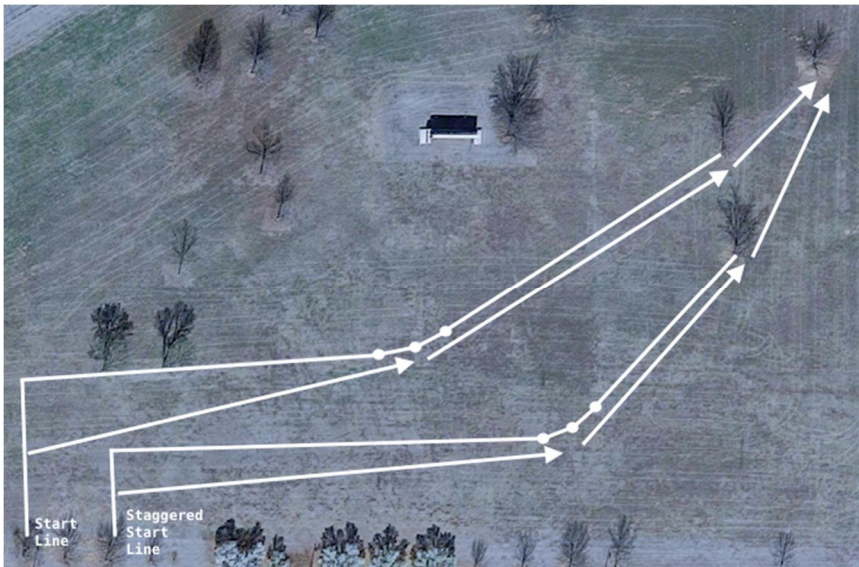
BIB

START LINE INFORMATION

IN ORDER TO ACCOMMODATE MORE ATHLETES AT THE START LINE WE HAVE ADDED A SECOND, STAGGERED START LINE, 18 METERS IN FRONT OF THE START LINE. YOUR TEAM HAS THE OPTION OF STARTING FROM EITHER LINE.

BOTH LINES ARE EQUAL DISTANCE TO THE MERGE.



IF YOUR ATHLETES USE THE ORIGINAL START LINE, THEY MUST STAY TO THE RIGHT OF THEIR COURSE LINE TO THE TURN POINT.

IF YOUR ATHLETES USE THE STAGGERED START LINE, THEY MUST STAY TO THE RIGHT OF THEIR COURSE LINE TO THE TURN POINT.
