

SILO REBEL'S INVITATIONAL @ FT. WASHITA

Date: September 17, 2019

Location: Ft. Washita located between Madill and Durant, Oklahoma.

Fort Washita was established in 1842 to protect the Chickasaw and Choctaw Indians from the plains Indians. The post was abandoned in April 1861 and occupied by Confederate forces. The site was returned to the Chickasaw in 1870 and remained in private hands until the Oklahoma Historical Society acquired it in 1962. As of 2017, Ft. Washita is once again in the hands of the Chickasaw Nation.

Reconstructed buildings, stone ruins, and a visitor center present a unique glimpse of military life in the pre-Civil War West.
