FESTIVAL LOCATION: Deer Creek High School, 6101 NW 206th St, Edmond, OK 73012. The course starts & finishes north & west of our high school & intermediate school, follows the perimeter of our practice athletic fields, and is flat & spectator friendly. Buses should park in the Performing Arts & Athletic Center (PAAC) parking lot adjacent to MacArthur Blvd.

Teams and students must be entered on-line before the deadline through your **ENDURO USA™** account. <u>Teams will not be added at the meet</u>. Each Team will receive a packet with bibs for each runner. The bib must be worn on the front (chest area). Students will not be allowed to start/enter a race without his/her bib. AWARDS: Top 30 individuals receive medals (CUSTOM MEDALS by ENDURO) in each division. We will score each division.

ENTRY FEES:

• \$100.00 for all 3 divisions/races per gender, so \$200 max for both boys and girls; the entry fees were raised for three reasons:
1) 2 day format 2) increased medals with more overall divisions 3) our district does not want to charge gate or have concession to reduce contacts with money exchanging and yet we still want to cover our costs. The decision to have races two days was made to facilitate many schools' likely limitations on students per bus, as well as reduce the number of athletes

SPECTATORS POLICIES/ ADMISSION:

- All spectators will be encouraged to wear a mask, in accordance with Deer Creek School District policy.
- Spectators are defined as anyone not competing, coaching, or volunteering in the event. While we understand that camaraderie and support of one's teammates is a vital component of cross country, the current circumstances require that we do our best to control crowds. Thus, non-competing teammates cannot simply walk or ride in with their team.
- The starting line area, the finish line area, and the chute will be strictly limited to athletes and coaches--no spectators.

TEAM CAMP ASSIGNMENTS:

- Teams entered in the meet will be assigned to 3 pre-determined team camp areas, in order to appropriately spread out teams and avoid congestion and gatherings in any one area.
- Team Camp Area 1: Intermediate School Softball Field (Edmond North, Edmond Santa Fe, Piedmont, PC West)
- Team Camp Area 2: Intermediate School Baseball Field (Choctaw, Moore, Mustang, Shawnee, Stillwater)
- Team Camp Area 3: Upper Field Soccer Complex (Bishop Kelley, Broken Arrow, Enid, Jenks, Union)
