

## WATONGA Cross Country Invitational Saturday, September 4, 2021



**Location:** From HWY 33, travel 3 miles north on HWY 8; then go West  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile. The course is on the south side of the road. There are no dressing facilities at the site, porta-potties will be available. There will be a \$5 per car gate admission.

**Runners:** Any number of runners may participate from a school and compete for individual medals, but only the top seven will be used in team scoring.

**Awards:** Medals for the top 30 places in each of the High School and Middle School Divisions.

Middle School Division is for 8<sup>th</sup> grade and under.

For athlete eligibility purposes, make sure middle school athletes and high school athletes are entered separately through the appropriate ENDURO Entries account. I will add additional athletes, if needed, the day of the meet and make changes. But, we can not add an athlete if his/her TEAM has not entered the meet on-line (www.enduroentries.com) before the entry deadline. --- So, please enter your TEAM (athletes) before the deadline.
