Entry Deadline

ALL ENTRIES ARE DUE BY MONDAY, APRIL 11, 2011 AT 6:00 PM (CENTRAL DAYLIGHT TIME). NO EXCEPTIONS!

Entry Procedure

Entries are to be done online with Direct Athletics (www.directathletics.com). Phone or faxed entries will not be accepted.

NOTE THAT YOU MUST CHOOSE YOUR DIVISION WHEN ENTERING WITH DIRECT ATHLETICS. DIVISION I WILL BE 6A ONLY WHILE DIVISION II WILL BE SA AND BELOW.

If you do not already have an account with Direct Athletics you will need to create one prior to entering the meet. To create an account with Direct Athletics, visit the website, click the "New Users Click Here" button, and then follow the instructions.

Entry Fee

\$100.00 per team, per gender (\$100.00 for girls, \$100.00 for boys). Teams of 14 or fewer athletes will be charged \$7.00 per individual. Checks can be made payable to The University of Oklahoma for those paying at packet pick-up. School name and address MUST BE provided for any teams not paying at packet pick-up.

Declarations/Scratches

There will be no formal scratch or declaration procedure. You can change your entries as often as you like up to the close of entries on MONDAY, APRIL 11 at 6:00 PM. Whatever you have entered with Direct Athletics at 6:00 PM on MONDAY will be considered your FINAL DECLARED ENTRIES. After that time you will need to contact the meet director with ALL scratches as soon as you know them. This can be done by email (jill.steele@ou.edu).

ONCE ONLINE ENTRIES CLOSE YOU WILL ONLY BE ABLE TO MAKE SCRATCHES YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO MAKE ADDITIONS, SUBSTITUTIONS OR CHANGES AND THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONS, SUBSTITUTIONS OR CHANGES ON MEET DAY PLEASE MAKE ANY AND ALL SCRATCHES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE SO THAT WE CAN SEED THE MEET CORRECTLY AND TAKE THE BEST POSSIBLE CARE OF YOUR ATHLETES AND TEAMS.

Event Field Sizes

Each school may enter THREE athletes per event and one relay team. There will be no "B" teams accepted into the meet.

Meet Schedule

The schedule given here is tentative and may be revised upon the close of entries. If changes are made, you will be able to pick up a revised schedule at packet pickup, or find the schedule online at soonersports.com. WE WILL BE UTILIZING A ROLLING TIME SCHEDULE.

Packets

Coaches may begin picking up packets in the lobby of the Mosier Indoor Center at 8:30 am on Saturday, April 10.

VERY IMPORTANT. All coaches need to check in and pick up a team packet before their athletes will be allowed to compete. Payment of entry fees, or arrangement for payment of entry fees, must also be done at this time. The team packets will contain wristbands for each athlete.

It is VERY IMPORTANT that each athlete wear a wristband for the duration of the meet. Without a wristband they will not be allowed to check in and they WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

Check In

Athletes in the running events need to check in at the north end of the Mosier indoor facility 30 minutes prior to their event(s). RUNNING EVENT ATHLETES THAT DO NOT CHECK IN 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO AN EVENT WILL BE SCRATCHED FROM THAT EVENT AND WILL NOT BE ADDED BACK TO THE FIELD FOR THAT EVENT. Field event athletes will check in at the event site(s).

Divisions

There will be two divisions. Division I will be 6A only - Division II will be 5A and below. YOU NEED TO CHOOSE THE CORRECT DIVISION WHEN ENTERING ONLINE WITH DIRECT ATHLETICS.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event per division. Championship team trophies will be awarded to the winning team in each division, as well as to the runner-up team. Finally, the winning girls and boys coaches in each division will receive a John Jacobs Invitational wristwatch.

Scoring

Scoring will be 10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1 with relays being doubled.

Rules

The meet will be conducted under the rules of the Oklahoma Secondary Schools Association.

Parking

There is parking available in the eastern most portion of the Duck Pond parking lot. Enter from Brooks Street and head to the far east end of the lot (the end closest to the Duck Pond). A pedestrian gate on the northeast corner of the John Jacobs Track Facility is open to a sidewalk that crosses over to the entryway of the Mosier Indoor Facility.

Because of classes on the Norman campus, only cars belonging to spectators and competitors parked in the east end of the lot will not be ticketed. Access to Brooks Street is possible from north or southbound Jenkins Avenue (the street that runs on the east side of Oklahoma Memorial Stadium).

Implements

Competitors in the shot and discus must have their implements weighed prior to competition. Weigh in will be done in the Mosier Center.

Spikes

Spikes must not exceed 1/4". High jumpers may use 3/8" spikes. Though not required, pyramid spikes are preferred.

Infield Access

Coaches and non-participating athletes are not allowed on the track, inside the throwing venue, or on the infield at any time.

Hip Numbers

Hip and chest numbers are required for all running event athletes and can be picked up at check in. Numbers are to be worn on the left and right hips as well as on the left chest.

Electronic Devices

No electronic devices are allowed in the competition or warm-up areas of the facility.

Team Camps

Space is available on the North side of the track for team tents. Please be prepared to stake your tents down should we have high winds.

Meet Admission

We will be charging admission for the meet. \$5.00 per adult. Ages 13 and below are FREE.
