Entries: Each team is limited to three (3) individual entries per event and one (1) relay. Aditionally, teams will be allowed

four (4) Wild Card entries (see below).

Entry Deadline is Wednesday, April 22 at Midnight. All entries must be submitted to trackroster.com by completing

steps 1-5, including times and distances for seeding.

Seeding: This will be a pre-seeded meet. It is important that you enter a mark on trackroster.com for each entry in order for the

meet to run as smoothly as possible. This is the same entry procedure that teams will follow for Regional

Championship Meets.

Wild Cards: Each team has four (4) Wild Card Entries. These are a fourth unscored entry that can compete in addition to your three

scored entries in an event. These wildcard entries must be entered normally on trackroster.com and declared at the

coaches meeting.

Rules: We will follow all OSSAA and National Federation rules. Each participant is limited to four events. Scoring will be

10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 (assuming 9 teams or more). Relays will be double points.

Divisions: 6A boys, 6A girls, 5A and under boys, 5A and under girls.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event. A plaque will be awarded for the top team in each

division. A traveling trophy will also be awarded for the track town challenge (see below).

Entry Fee: \$90 per team (\$180 for Boys and Girls). No B teams. \$20 per person for teams of four (4) or fewer.
