4. Medal will be awarded to the first five places in each event. Relays will be the first three places.
5. **NO TEAM SCORES WILL BE KEPT AND NO TEAM TROPHIES AWARDED.**
6. All running events will be timed finals.
7. A team may enter extra athletes per event, with each athlete limited to four events.
8. Runners will be heated before each event.
