Watonga High School/Middle School Track and Field Meet

Watonga High School will be hosting an open invitational track meet limited to the first 10 High Schools and Middle Schools that email me and let me know they are planning to attend on April 24, 2020. This is an invite to any 4A and below school. We have a 7 lane track and an 8 lane straight, full pour polyurethane track surface that was installed in November of 2015 and a fully automatic timing system. There will be four (4) divisions: MS Girls and Boys and HS Girls and Boys.

We will follow the state association rules and regulations and the following:

- Only school in class 4A and below may enter the meet. 10 TEAM/SCHOOL LIMIT !!!
- This will be an all finals meet.
- Only four (4) events may be entered by one contestant.
- Each team may enter three (3) contestants per individual event, and one team per relay. B-Teams will be allowed if you have them.
- Points will be scored 10-8-6-4-2-1 and will double for relays 20-16-12-8-4-2.
- Five (5) medals will be awarded in each individual event and three (3) for Relays. No Team Trophies will be awarded.
- An entry fee of \$75.00 per division or \$150.00 for both girls and boys for each school team will be charged. Max of \$300.00 for all four (4) divisions. If you enter a B Team and would like them to score and medal the fee will be \$60.00 per team, \$15.00 per individual up to 4. Make checks payable to Watonga High School. No refunds.
- This is a Rosters ONLY meet. Entries are to be completed online using Enduroentries (www.enduroentries.com). Phone or faxed entries will not be accepted.
- Schools must have rosters entered on Enduroentries by April 22, 2020.
- ¹/₄ö or less spikes will be required in the running and jumping events. Violation of this rule may result in disqualification.
- Contestants will be heated on the field for their running event.
- Athletes will not be allowed on the field unless they are warming up or competing in an event at the time.
- Coaches meeting at 9:30 am. Field events and running events will start at 10:00 am.
- A concession stand will be open. Coaches will receive a meal ticket for lunch.
