<u>Visiting Fans Parking:</u> Parking on the side of Carrier or Oakwood Rd will not be permitted as it is a liability as well as safety concern.

<u>Visiting Fans Seating:</u> Fans may sit on the North of South end bleachers. Fans that wish to roam to other events on campus will be asked to be mindful when crossing the track at all times.

<u>Visiting Team:</u> Busses will enter and depart at the gate by the shot put. Visiting athletes and their coaching staff will enter into the track area through the SE 'Team Entrance Only' gate only.

<u>Coaches Hospitality Expectations:</u> Only track operation workers/volunteers, coaching staff, & administration will be permitted into Roydon Tilley Fieldhouse for access to hospitality.

Admission: \$10.00 Cash OR \$8.35 Digital Pass

<u>Passes:</u> The only passes that will be honored for free entry will be OSSAA, OCA, & CPS Faculty passes. No other passes will be accepted.

Bus Parking: Busses will park in the SE lot that is located to the West of the discus area.

VISITING FAN

Visiting Fans will be asked to enter the track meet through the NW Gate Entrance. Fans may park on the Northside of the track following Oakwood Rd OR at the HS lots following Carrier Rd.

VISITING TEAM INFO

Visiting Teams & Busses will be asked to enter through the first driveway to your left when heading North on Oakwood Rd. Team Busses will park in the open lot next to the discus throw & enter through the SE gate.

VISITING COACHES/STAFF

Visiting Coaches/Staff: Roydon Tiley Fieldhouse is where our hospitality room will be located. Only track operation workers, coaching staffs, & visiting school administration are permitted into Tiley Fieldhouse for usage of hospitality room.

Emergency Action Plan

Sport: Track Year: 2023

- 1) First to arrive on the scene provides first aid.
- 2) Send a coach, manager, or uninjured athlete to notify the ATC and get the AED (If not on-site).
- 3) If the ATC can not be located, the head coach will become the leader.

Leader: Holly Wofford

 Will be in charge of the emergency situation and will instruct all others on the emergency team.

Leader's Assistant: Jayden Dobbs

- Will assist the leader in the evaluation of the injured athlete.

Phone Caller: Christi Staab

- Will go to the nearest phone and activate the EMS
- Will inform the dispatcher of:
 - The nature of the injury and the age of the athlete
 - The location of the athlete and direction to the site
 - Will not hang up until the dispatcher advises to do so
 - Nearest Phone: Self or R.Tilley Fieldhouse
 - Ambulance Entrance: West Gate of Track

Person to meet the EMS: Jayden Dobbs

- Will contact any necessary staff to assure access for the ambulance
- Will meet the ambulance at the designated entrance and lead them to the injured athlete

Person to accompany athlete to the hospital: Cindy Black

- Will ride the athlete in the ambulance in the event of the parents cannot be located
- Will take the athlete's emergency info to the hospital

It is the certified ATC or coach's responsibility to inform the administrator of the incident. It is the certified ATC or coach's responsibility to inform the athlete's parents of the injury immediately.

It is the certified ATC's responsibility to document the circumstances surrounding the activity and all actions taken.

Emergency medical info for each athlete is to accompany the team at all times.
